

Roads Cyclists Are Prohibited On

For the safety of cyclists, cycling is not allowed on road stretches where vehicles travel at higher speeds. Under the Road Traffic Act, cyclists are not allowed on these types of roads:

Expressways;
Expressway tunnels;
Road tunnels;
Any slip road linked to expressways; &
Any interchange between 2 or more expressways.
