
TIPS FOR SAFE PASSING AND OVERTAKING ON ROADS



FOR CYCLISTS


Single-lane Roads:

- Look out for traffic and give way to others where practical and safe. Slow down or stop if necessary.
- Do not ride abreast on single-lane roads.



Multi-lane Roads:

- Observe group length limit (5 cyclists in single file, or 10 cyclists riding 2 abreast) and maintain a minimum distance of 30m or 2 lamp posts between groups.
- Keep to a single lane and signal before changing lanes.








FOR MOTORISTS

Single-lane Roads:

- Slow down and overtake only when it is safe to do so.
- Do not sound your horn continuously at cyclists until they give way.



Multi-lane Roads:

- Overtake only when the next lane is clear and allow 1.5m passing distance.
- Do not drive too close and force cyclists to the side.
