




# Where active mobility devices are allowed to be used

<b>Path/ Road</b>  <b>Device type</b>	<b>Footpath</b> Typically paths beside roads and within HDB estates	<b>Cycling Path</b> Paths marked with 'Cyclist' or 'PCN' logos	<b>Road</b> Except for expressways and road tunnels
<b>Bicycle</b>	  	  	  
<b>Power-assisted Bicycle (PAB)</b> or e-bike	  	  	  
<b>Motorised Personal Mobility Device (PMD)</b> e.g. e-scooter, e-unicycle, hoverboard*	  	  	  
<b>Non-motorised PMD</b> e.g. manual kick scooter	  	  	  
<b>Personal Mobility Aid (PMA)</b> e.g. mobility scooter or electric wheelchair	  	  	  

\*From 3 April 2020, the riding of motorised PMDs, including e-scooters, are prohibited from footpaths.



It is an offence to ride a device on a path or road which it is prohibited from. If caught, you may be subjected to penalties, such as fines up to \$2,000 and jailtime of up to 3 months.
