



Background

Rapid Transit Systems (Restricted Activities) Regulations (RPRA) What we regulate Restricted activity (i.e. heavy machinery operation, trench excavation, tentage and etc) fall within the railway protection zone

• To refine and update the processes and requirements in the regulations so that they are in line with current industry practice.

Key Amendments in RPRA (1/2)




Current Regs RPRA 2003	Revised Regs RPRA 2021
Reg 5 – No part of crane to encroach within 6 metres from	Deletion of Reg 5 and subsumed into Reg 7
edge of railway	

Note:

- LTA may now grant special approval for crane operation (or any restricted activity) within 6m (or 1st reserve) from the edge of railway as buildings are now unavoidably closer to RTS structures.
- Separate application for special approval is not required if the proposed restricted activity is within 6m (or 1st reserve) from the edge of railway.
- QP and applicants shall ensure additional safety control measures are in place to mitigate any risk pose onto the RTS structures.
- LTA's approval letter will clearly indicate if the permission granted is for:
 - 1. Scenario 1 works within Railway Protection Zone but outside of 6m
 - 2. Scenario 2 works within Railway Protection Zone and within 6m

Key Amendments in RPRA (2/2)



	Current Regs RPRA 2003	Revised Regs RPRA 2021
	Reg 7 – Railway protection zone	Reg 7 – Permission for restricted activity

Note:


- Written permission is required from LTA prior to the carrying out of restricted activity within railway protection zone.
- Separate application is not required under the RPRA Regs should the "engineering works" which is defined under the DBW Regs fall within the meaning of "restricted activities" under the RPRA Regs

Submission process & requirements



- 1. Application for Permission to Carry Out Trench and Pit Excavation Within Railway Protection Zone
- 2. Application for Permission to Erect Temporary Sheds/Tents/Shelters within Railway Protection Zone

All documents must be in PDF format and attachment size shall be < 10MB




Submission process & requirements



 Other restricted activity which requires PE endorsed design calculation and drawings

i.e. heavy machinery operation; installation of boreholes, wells, sheet-piles, pile foundation; tunnelling for the purpose of service/utility conduit and etc.

Use LTA-DBC_RAILS.XFD form → choose application 3
