

CHECKLIST FOR SECURITY OFFICERS

The authorised security officers are to ensure they have the following items before duty:

- Security agency's uniform
- Reflective yellow safety vest
- Matching reflective yellow gloves
- Dark coloured jockey cap with security agency's logo on the front of the cap
- Dark coloured covered footwear
- Communication device (i.e. walkie talkie)
- Whistle
- Traffic wand
- Flare light (optional)
- Weather protection clothing (optional)

AUTHORISATION OF SECURITY OFFICERS TO REGULATE TRAFFIC FOR ROAD WORKS

INTRODUCTION

Road works are carried out to facilitate the upgrading/ maintenance/ installation of road facilities and/or installation of utilities beneath the roads.

To ensure the safety of road users and stakeholders, as well as to minimise traffic congestion and inconvenience while works are being carried out, proper traffic control is needed.

Effective April 2015, security agencies are required to apply for authorisation from the Land Transport Authority (LTA), on behalf of their qualified security officers, to perform traffic regulation duties for road works.

ELIGIBILITY OF QUALIFIED SECURITY OFFICERS

To be authorised to perform the traffic regulation duties, the qualified security officers shall meet the following minimum requirements:

- Possess the relevant qualification to regulate traffic, i.e. successfully completed the training course on “Conduct Crowd and Traffic Control” under the Security Workforce Skills Qualifications (WSQ) framework;
- Licensed and trained/ exempted by the Police Licensing & Regulatory Department under the Private Security Industry Act; and
- Employed by a security agency licensed by the Police Licensing & Regulatory Department under the Private Security Industry Act.

SCOPE OF TRAFFIC REGULATION DUTIES

Authorised security officer may regulate traffic arising from road works for the following road configurations:

- Mid-block crossings
- Non-signalised junctions
- Signalised junctions with 2 or less vehicular approaches
- Closure of any road with 2 or less vehicular approaches

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- To apply for authorisation from the Authority, the submission must be made via LTA.PROMPT (<https://prompt.lta.gov.sg>) at least 5 working days prior to the actual deployment of authorised security officers for traffic regulation duties.

SAFETY ATTIRE REQUIREMENTS

When the authorised security officer is on duty, he is required to put on the following safety attire (over his security agency’s uniform):

Safety Vest

Material:

- 100% polyester knit fabric
- Lightweight and cool

Colour:

- High-visibility luminous yellow with double horizontal and vertical retroreflective bands which comply with European Standard EN471 Class 2

Label:

- Name tag with the name of the officer and agency prominently displayed on the top left corner of the front vest
- “Traffic Control” on the back of the vest

Others

- Matching reflective traffic gloves
- Dark coloured jockey cap with security agency’s logo on the front of the cap
- Dark coloured covered shoes
- Optional: Weather protection clothing shall also meet the requirements of the safety vest
