

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) relating to enhanced safe distancing measures for Point-to-Point (P2P) Drivers

1. In view of the safe distancing measures announced to reduce transmission, as a Taxi or Private Hire Care (PHC) driver, can I continue to drive?

Taxi and PHC drivers play an important frontline role in ensuring Singaporeans can still continue to get from place to place. Therefore, they are deemed to be providing essential services for the public and will be allowed to continue providing Point-to-Point (P2P) services, and courier or food delivery services.

2. As a Taxi or PHC driver, what can I do to protect myself during this period?

Both taxi and PHC Operators will continue to support drivers with masks, sanitisers and disinfectants where possible. Temasek Foundation has kindly also provided 100,000 bottles of hand sanitizers to frontline transport workers such as taxi drivers, bus drivers and PHC drivers. Distribution of these sanitizers is ongoing. Drivers who run out of masks or sanitizers, should approach their operators for assistance.
