

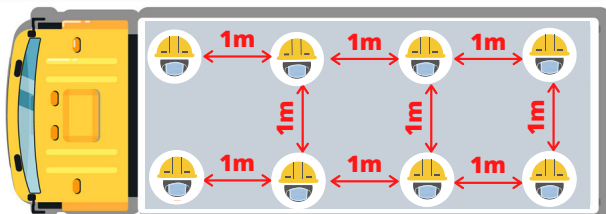
# SAFE DISTANCING FOR WORKERS ON LORRIES

The Ministry of Manpower and the Land Transport Authority issued an advisory on safe distancing measures for workers ferried by lorries on 10 April 2020.

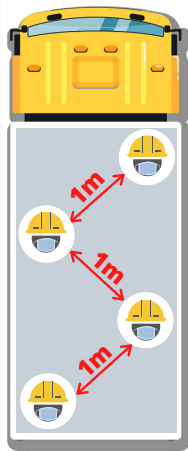
Employers must:

- Review maximum seating capacity to ensure occupants are seated at least 1m apart
- Clearly mark sitting locations
- Arrange for additional trips or lorries, if necessary
- Ensure workers wear masks at all times
- Communicate these safe distancing measures to your workers and drivers

\*Note: These are examples of how safe distancing on lorries can be practised.



An employer who contravenes the **COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020** faces a fine of up to \$10,000 or jail term of up to 6 months, or both. For second or subsequent offences, the penalties will be doubled.
