Silver Zone Road Safety Features

1) Gateway Treatment

Marking the start of a Silver Zone, it encourages motorists to slow down and drive with care, keeping a conscientious lookout for pedestrians. Silver Zones will have a lower speed limit of 40 km/h, where feasible.



2) Pinch Point with Informal Crossing

Reduces crossing distance and provides seniors with a two-stage crossing so that they can rest momentarily at the pedestrian refuge (centre divider) before continuing to cross the road.



3) Raised Informal Crossing

A raised platform similar to a bus-friendly hump, this crossing helps to calm traffic while elevating and facilitating pedestrians in crossing the road.



4) Extended Green Man Phase

Senior pedestrians can enjoy more time to cross the road at all traffic crossings in Silver Zones.



5) Chicane

Comprising of a series of S-shaped curves, motorists are encouraged to drive slowly and carefully.



6) Mountable Centre Dividers

Being low in height, these dividers allow vehicles to mount atop them during emergencies. They also regulate traffic and encourage motorists to travel slower.



7) Raised Junction

A raised platform covering an entire intersection to make it more conspicuous to motorists, this junction encourages them to reduce their speeds and drive carefully.



8) Flushed LED road studs at Raised Zebra Crossing

These studs light up at night to increase the conspicuity of the zebra crossing to motorists so that they will be more alert to crossing pedestrians.



9) Roundabout

A roundabout is a circular intersection in which traffic flows continuously in one direction around a central island. Apart from encouraging motorists to travel at lower speeds, it also reduces traffic conflict points and better regulates the traffic flow.
