

Public Transport Study Awards

Launched in November 2015, the Public Transport Study Awards are offered as part of the overall plan to attract, develop, and retain skilled workforce for the public transport industry. They consist of scholarships, book prizes and sponsorships for continuing education and training programmes.

These initiatives are funded by the Public Transport Manpower Development Fund (PTMDF), and are open to Singapore citizens.

Scholarships

Scholarships for a range of Pre-Employment Training engineering programmes are available for students who want to embark on a rewarding and meaningful career in the public transport industry. The scholarship includes tuition fees for selected programmes and a monthly allowance.

Book prizes

Book prizes are monetary awards presented to students in selected engineering programmes for outstanding academic performance.

Sponsorships

To ensure opportunities for staff development, growth and progression within the industry, sponsorships are available for existing public transport workers to pursue Continuing Education and Training programmes. The second batch of recipients for the Public Transport Sponsorship is currently enrolled in the MSc Railway Engineering and Integration programme conducted by the University of Birmingham, and Masters in Management (Urban Transportation) conducted by Singapore University of Social Sciences.
