There will be a series of gradual road closures in the Marina Centre area to facilitate setting up and removing of temporary race infrastructure during this period.

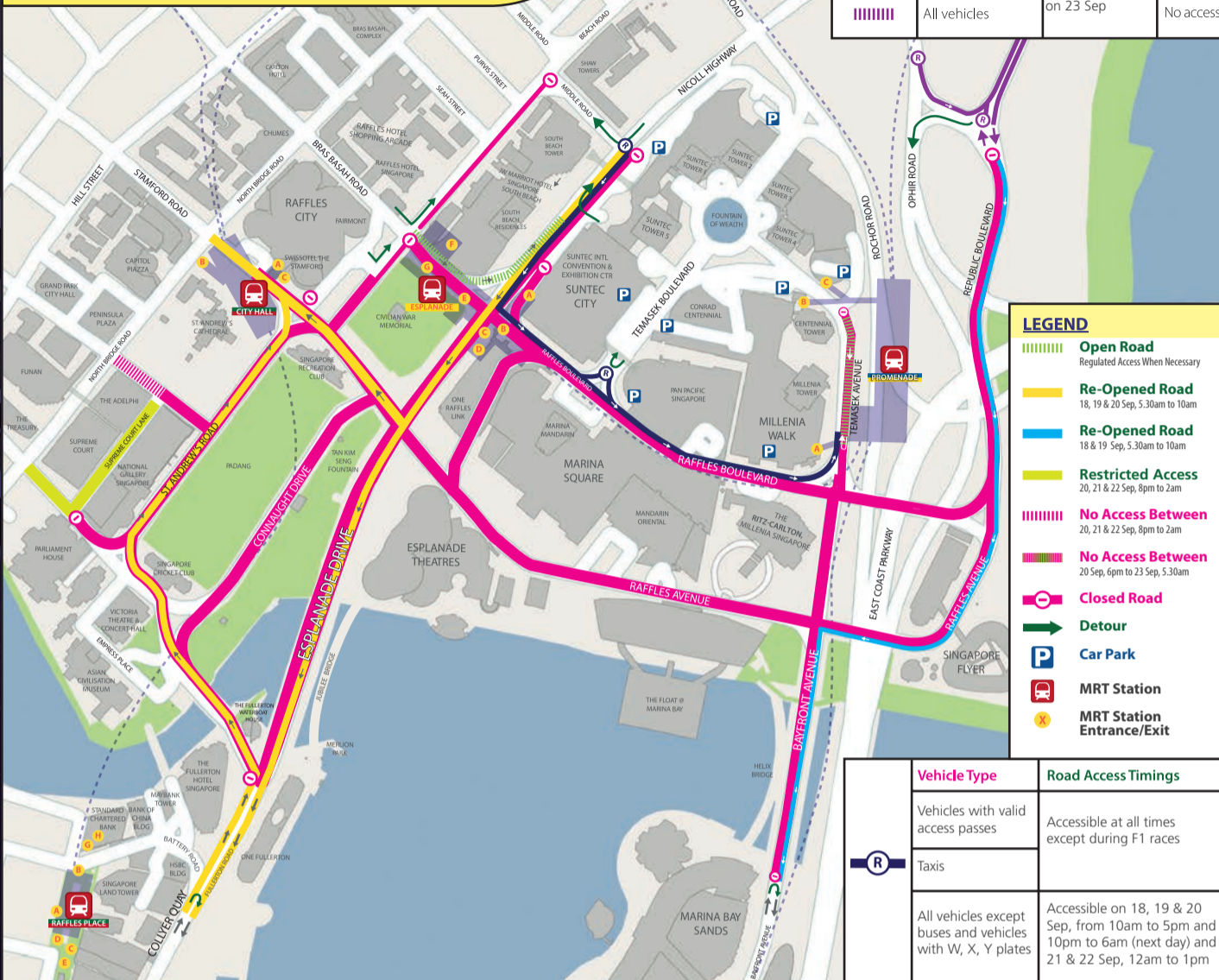

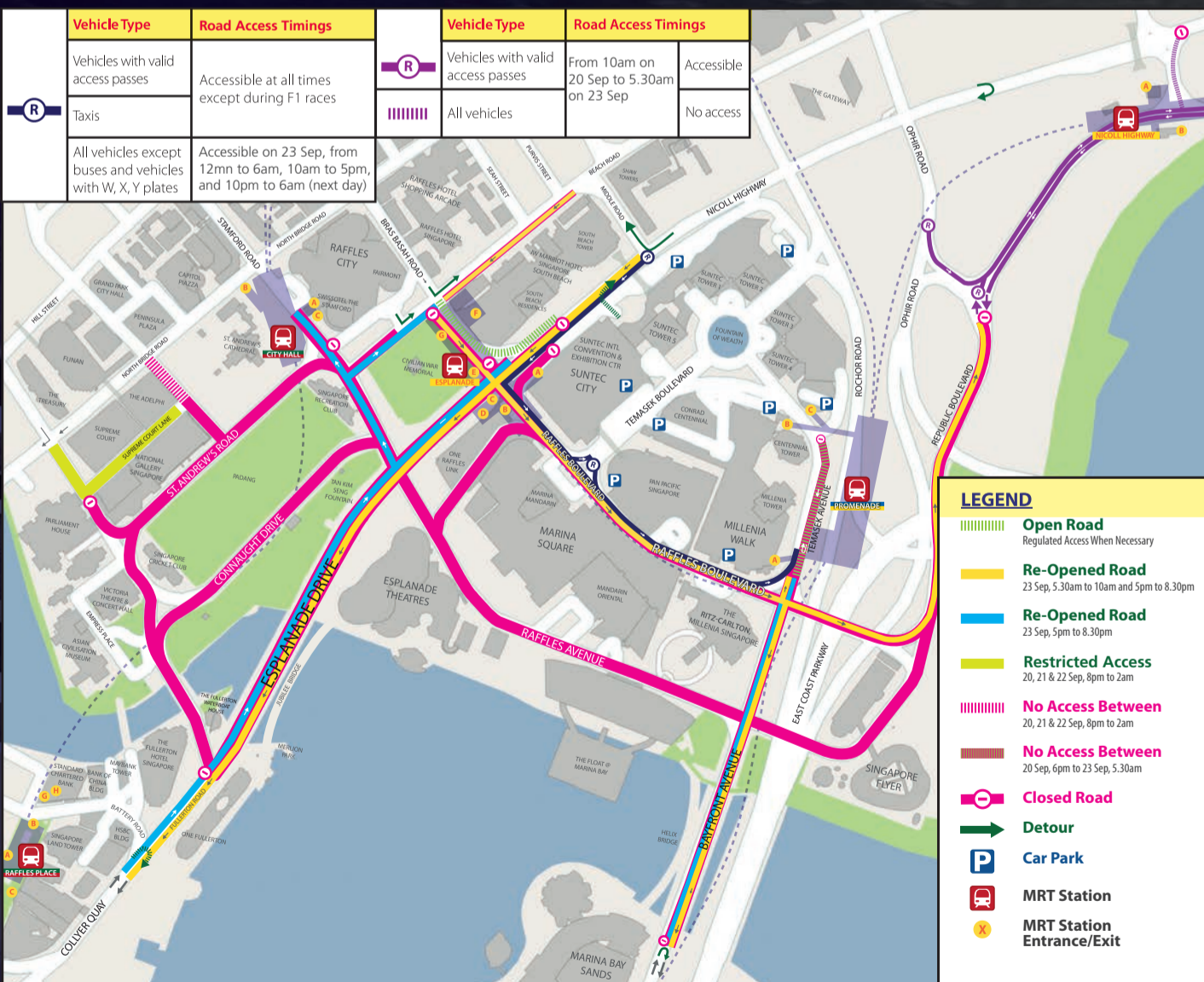

HOW TO GET THERE

The Marina Centre area is easily accessible by public transport. You are strongly encouraged to use public transport to get to your destinations around the area. This guide contains important information that will help you plan your journey during the affected period.

IF YOU TAKE PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- MRT services will be available at City Hall station till approximately 12.30am for 20 and 21 September 2019, and 12.45am for 22 September 2019.
- Last train timings can be obtained at the Passenger Service Centres in MRT stations or on www.mytransport.sg
- There will be a free shuttle bus service connecting Lavender MRT station to Gate 1 of the circuit park from 20 to 22 September 2019. The shuttle bus service operates from 2.30pm to 12.30am on 20 and 21 September, and from 3.30pm to 12.45am on 22 September.
- All pedestrian underpasses and overhead bridges in Marina Centre area will remain open.

IF YOU TAKE A TAXI

- Taxis will be allowed entry into the Marina Centre area at all times, except when F1 races are underway.
- Please refer to the maps overleaf for the complete list of road access timings and locations.
- However, in the event of high traffic volume, admission to these roads may be restricted, except for police vehicles, emergency vehicles and vehicles with valid access passes.

IF YOU DRIVE

- Please refer to the maps overleaf for the complete list of road access timings and locations.
- Car parks at Suntec City, Millenia Walk, and Marina Square will remain open (subject to availability).
- Car parks at Singapore Flyer, Esplanade, Singapore Recreation Club, Singapore Cricket Club, and Empress Place area will be closed to public.
- Various other car parks are accessible through a single lane along Raffles Boulevard via Nicoll Highway or Temasek Boulevard, which will be re-opened to traffic during off-peak hours on the days indicated in the overleaf.
- The Marina Centre area is also accessible via Rochor Road to Temasek Boulevard. However, in the event of high traffic volume, admission to these roads may be restricted, except for police vehicles, emergency vehicles, and vehicles with valid access passes.
- Do look out for the yellow temporary road signs with symbols that indicate key destinations. Follow these signs at traffic junctions to help you get to your destinations.

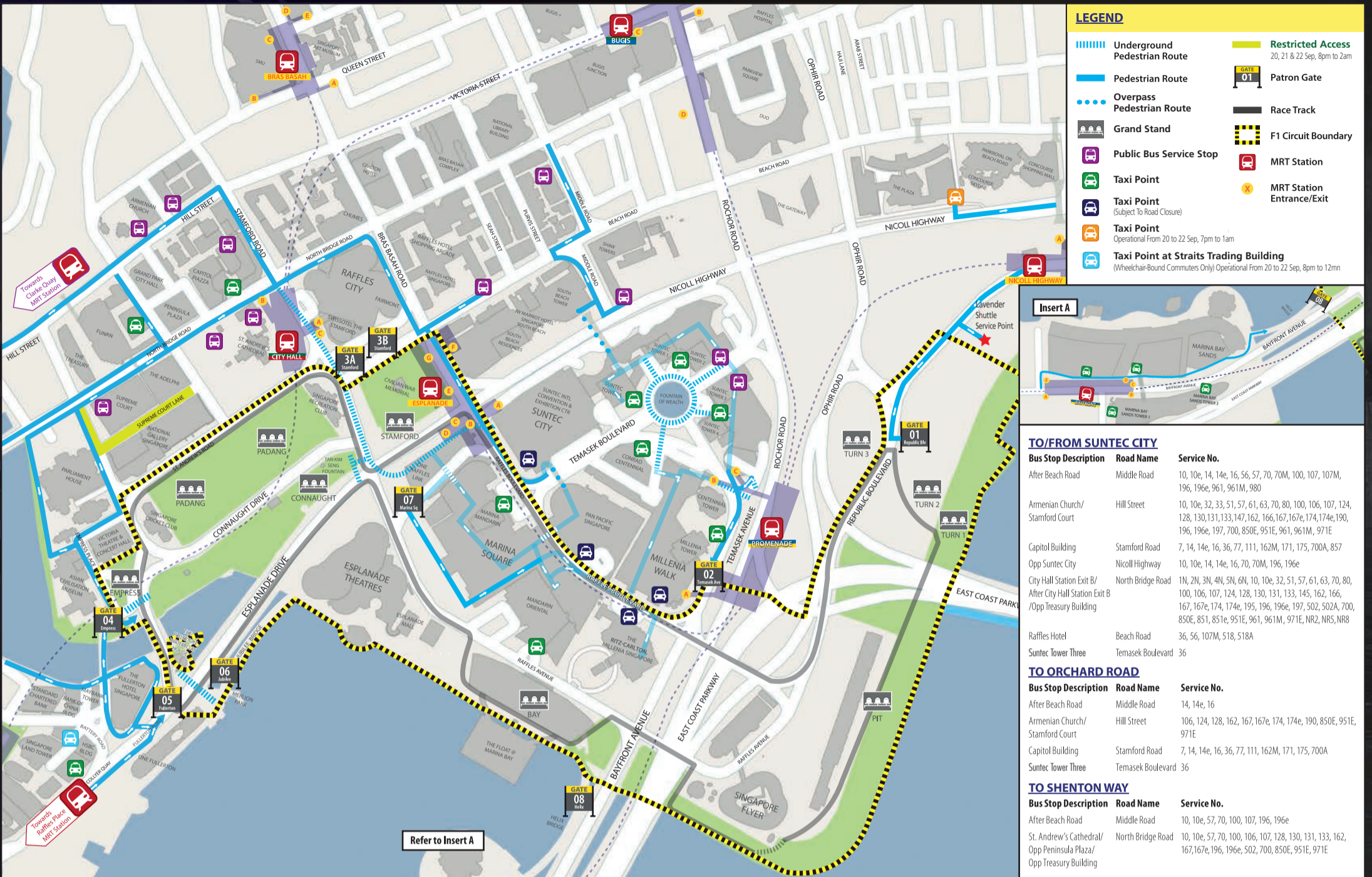
