

Annex B – Exemptions from mandatory OBU requirement

The mandatory OBU requirement will not apply to Singapore-registered motor vehicles that (i) do not use public roads on mainland Singapore, or (ii) are subject to strict usage restrictions. These include:

- Singapore-registered vehicles that are not allowed to travel on mainland public roads such as locomotives, tractors and construction equipment.
- Vehicles on Restricted Use Scheme such as airport vehicles, port vehicles, vehicles used solely in Pulau Ubin or other offshore islands, vehicles used for research and development purposes/racing/training/exhibition, vehicles on laid-up status, and vehicles under the Keeping Scheme.
- Non-mechanically propelled vehicles such as trailers.
- Classic and Vintage vehicles which are more sparingly used and subject to usage restrictions. For example, Classic vehicles can be used for up to 45 days in a calendar year. Classic and Vintage vehicle owners will be given the option to install the OBU and maintain current usage conditions and charges. Those who choose not to install the OBUs will be subject to further usage restrictions, as well as separate congestion fees. Further details will be provided at a later stage.
