| <p>(a) Off-Map MRT Tab</p>  | <p>Shows the general direction of the next nearest MRT station outside the map extent</p> |
| <p>(b) 5 min walk radius indicator</p>  | <p>Indicates the general area within 5 min or 400m from current location.</p> |
| <p>(c) Street finder grid</p>  | <p>Easy reference to legend for users to find streets on the map.</p> |
| <p>(d) 3D landmarks</p>  | <p>Showing the 3D form of prominent buildings and landmarks will help users better find their bearings.</p> |

(e) You are here indicator



Familiar map feature showing current location. Map has been designed to match the view of the map user for easy reading. This avoids the need for users to mentally rotate the map, if the map was designed as with the north direction at the top of the map.

(f) Main building entrances



An arrow indicates main building entrances, allowing users to easily identify where to enter the building so that they can navigate accordingly.

(g) MRT stations with exits



The map shows all the nearby entrances to MRT stations, including entrances within nearby developments, making it easy for users to find their nearest entrance.

(h) Active Mobility/Public Transport facilities and amenities



Salient features such as bus stops/ taxi stands, cycling paths (indicated with a red line) and bicycle parking facilities are indicated on the map to encourage the use of walking, cycling and taking public transport.
