However, those who need to use an oversized mobility device, must obtain a medical documentation on need for oversized device. This can be either a doctor's memo or a Certificate of Medical Need.	
Users of Government-subsidised mobility scooter	Beneficiaries and prospective first-time applicants of the Assistive Technology Fund (ATF)	No	Exempted from requirement to be granted a Certificate of Medical Need.

	First-time SMF applicants from 27 February 2026	Yes	To obtain a Certificate of Medical Need as part of SMF application process.
Users of non-subsidised mobility scooters	Using a device within allowable dimensions	Yes	To obtain a Certificate of Medical Need.
	Using a device larger than allowable dimensions	Yes	To obtain a Certificate of Medical Need to use an oversized device.
Past and future applicants of the Ministry of Health (MOH) disability schemes	Those who have been assessed with Activities of Daily Living (ADL) needs in either 'Mobility' or 'Transferring' via the Functional Assessment Report (FAR) or Severe Disability Assessment (SDA).	No	Exempted from the requirement to be granted a Certificate of Medical Need.
