² Prior to Aug 2012, taxi operators can bid for a new COE or pay Prevailing Quota Premium (PQP) to register a taxi under Category A. The latter is only in the case of a new taxi that replaces a deregistered one within 6 months.

³ Refers to the Early Turnover Scheme (ETS). From 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2025, vehicle owners can deregister their existing Euro 2/3/4 Category C diesel vehicles and register an eligible replacement vehicle within 1 month of deregistration by paying a discounted Prevailing Quota Premium(PQP) under the enhanced ETS.

Vehicles exempted from the VQS include scheduled and school buses, emergency vehicles, engineering plants primarily for off-the-road use, diplomatic vehicles and vehicles under the Disabled Person Scheme.
