¹ Figures are accurate as of published date and subjected to changes, including but not limited to, the grace period accorded for the revalidation of COEs. Figures include off peak cars and tax exempted vehicles.

² Prior to Aug 2012, taxi operators can bid for a new COE or pay Prevailing Quota Premium (PQP) to register a taxi under Category A. The latter is only in the case of a new taxi that replaces a deregistered one within 6 months. From 6 Aug 2012 onwards, all taxis pay for COEs based on the PQP of Category A.

³ Includes vehicles de-registered and eventually placed under the Early Turnover Scheme (ETS). From 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2025, vehicle owners can deregister their existing Euro 2/3/4 Category C diesel vehicles and register an eligible replacement vehicle within 1 month of deregistration by paying a discounted Prevailing Quota Premium(PQP) under the enhanced ETS.

⁴ Vehicles exempted from the VQS include scheduled and school buses, emergency vehicles, engineering plants primarily for off-the-road use, diplomatic vehicles and vehicles under the Disabled Person Scheme.

⁵ Cars registered with COEs obtained from the May 2022 1st bidding exercise onwards,
 - Category A: Non-fully electric cars with engines up to 1,600cc and Maximum Power Output up to 97kW (130bhp); and fully electric cars with Maximum Power Output up to 110kW (147bhp).
 - Category B: Non-fully electric cars with engines above 1,600cc or Maximum Power Output above 97kW (130bhp); and fully electric cars with Maximum Power Output above 110kW (147bhp).

Cars registered with COEs obtained from the Feb 2014 1st bidding exercise onwards but before the May 2022 1st bidding exercise,

- Category A: Cars with engine capacity up to 1,600cc and Maximum Power Output up to 97kW (130bhp).
 - Category B: Cars with engine capacity above 1,600cc or Maximum Power Output above 97kW (130bhp).

Cars registered with COEs obtained before the Feb 2014 1st bidding exercise,

- Category A: Cars with engine capacity up to 1,600cc.
 - Category B: Cars with engine capacity above 1,600cc.
