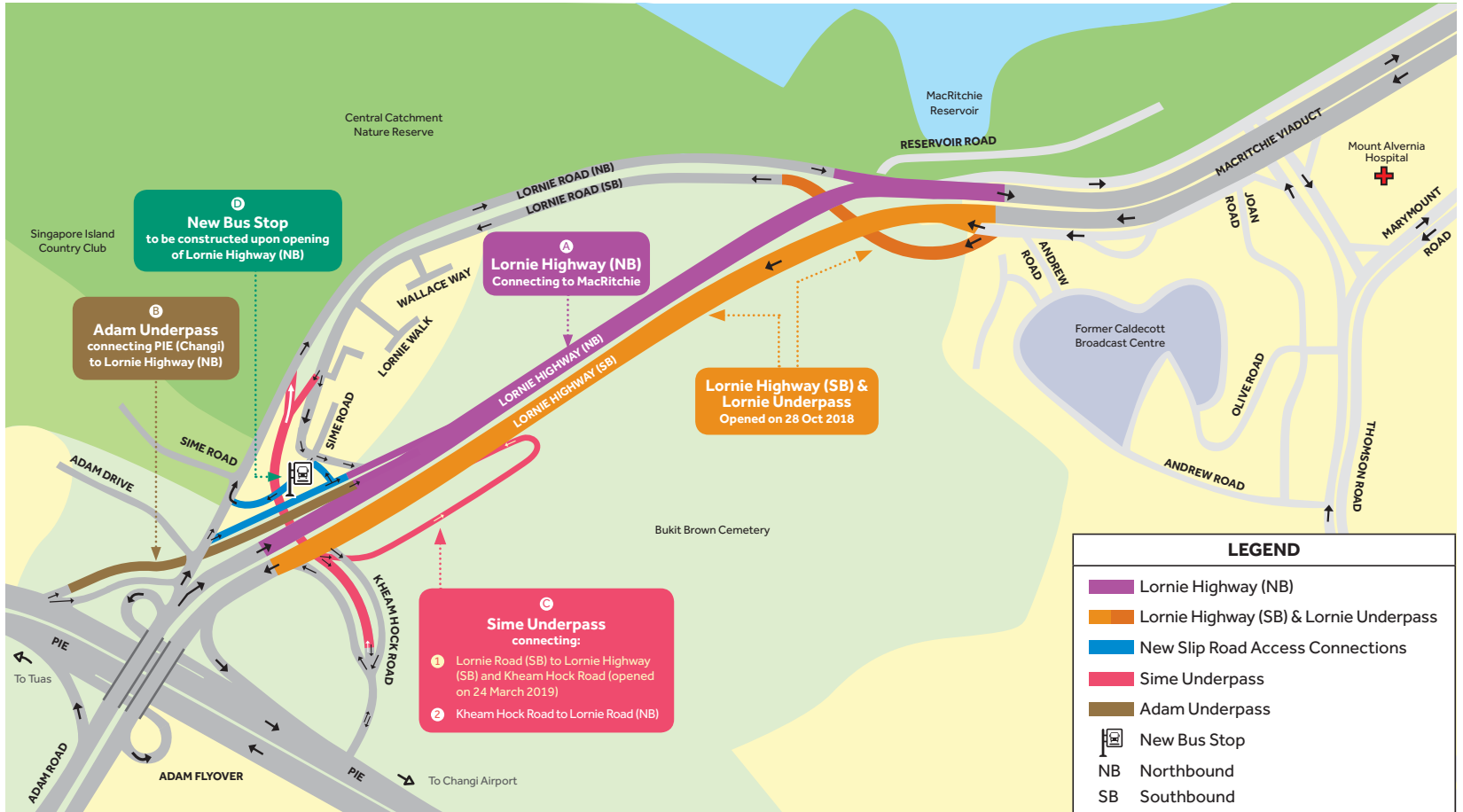


OPENING OF

THE NEW LORNIE HIGHWAY (Northbound)

Connecting you from PIE/Farrer Road to MacRitchie Viaduct

 **Opening on Friday, 19 April 2019, 3am**



The new northbound Lornie Highway connecting PIE/Farrer Road to MacRitchie Viaduct will open on 19 April 2019. The road will serve as a new link connecting motorists travelling from PIE/Farrer Road to MacRitchie Viaduct, Braddell Road and other surrounding roads.

With the opening of the new northbound Lornie Highway, do take note of the following changes:

ROAD CHANGES

- A** Motorists travelling from Farrer/Adam Road to Braddell/Upper Thomson Road are to use the new Lornie Highway to reach their destinations.
- B** Motorists travelling along PIE (Changi) to Braddell/Upper Thomson Road are to use the new Adam Underpass (Exit 20B) to get to Lornie Highway.
- C** Motorists travelling from southbound Lornie Road to PIE/Adam Road/Farrer Road/Kheam Hock Road are to use the new Sime Underpass.
- D** A new bus stop along the slip road will **be opened at a later date**. Five out of seven bus services that are currently plying northbound Lornie Road will be diverted to the new northbound Lornie Highway.

BUS ROUTES

Current Route	Changes to note
Services 52, 74, 93, 852 and 855 plying the northbound Lornie Road (towards MacRitchie Viaduct)	Services 52, 74, 93, 852 and 855 will be adjusted to ply the NEW northbound Lornie Highway (towards MacRitchie Viaduct) and will call at the new bus stop at the slip road when it is ready at a later date
Services 157 and 165 plying the northbound Lornie Road (towards MacRitchie Viaduct)	No change to bus stops served
