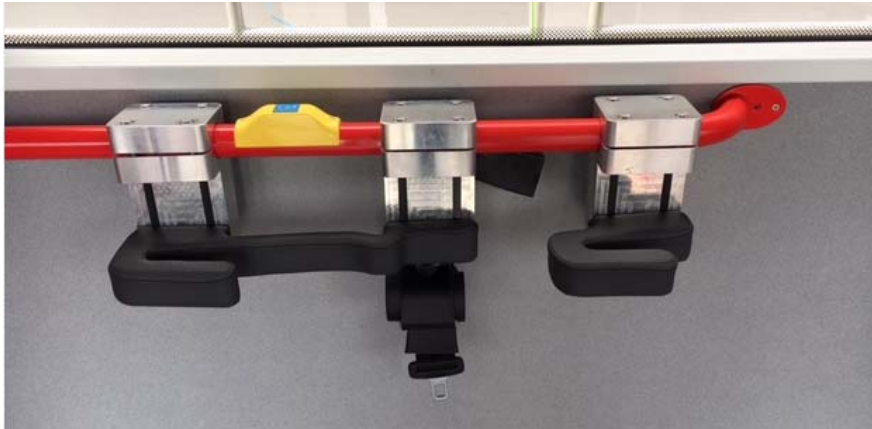


How to use the stroller restraint system

The system consists of two **slots** for insertion of the side handle of stroller, as well as a **retractable seatbelt**, to secure the stroller. The child should be seated with the stroller's seatbelts fastened. A forward facing stroller should use the slot closer to the front of the bus, while a backward facing stroller should use the slot closer to the rear of the bus.



Steps to put on stroller restraint

- Step 1: Identify which slot to use;
- Step 2: Insert the side handle of stroller into the handle slot;
- Step 3: Apply brakes of the stroller; and
- Step 4: Use the retractable seatbelt to secure the stroller to the system.

Steps to release stroller restraint

- Step 1: Detach the retractable seatbelt from the stroller;
- Step 2: Release brakes of the stroller; and
- Step 3: Move the side handle of stroller out of the handle slot
